Tips for Answering NCLEX Style Questions

The first step to correctly answering NCLEX-RN ® exam questions is to find out what each question is really asking. Step 1 Read each question carefully from the first word to the last word. Do not skim over the words or read them too quickly.

Item: the entire question and answer; Stem: the actual question, what is being asked; Options: possible responses; Correct answer: umm, the correct answer; Distractors: incorrect answers; Stem: There are 4 different ways a stem will be written on the NCLEX exam: Complete sentence; Incomplete sentence – becomes complete with the correct answer; Positive – asks a question regarding what is true

These are 20 Important Tips to help you chose the correct answer when dealing with NCLEX or other nursing exams questions : 1- Never choose an answer that leaves the patient: Always provide safety. 2- Don't “do nothing.”: Because you always have to do something. 3- Don't read into the question: Never assume anything that has not been specifically mentioned and [...]

Now look at the NCLEX answers presented. You'll see multiple choices that contain information on patient care and treatment. Next to each answer, mark down which age group the treatment would be appropriate for (i.e., child, adult, baby, etc.). Now compare the age groups in the NCLEX question and answer.

The distractors strengthen the question and allow students who know the information to pick the correct answers and to succeed on the test. However, writing distractors for nursing NCLEX style questions is often just as hard or even harder than writing the stem part of the question. The stem should be able to stand by itself.

Writing Good NCLEX Style Answers and Distractors - Part 1 ...

Skip The Question And Read The Answers First . Another way to help you answer the NCLEX questions correctly is to do the opposite. Instead of reading the question first, go directly to the answers. Read them aloud to better understand them if you must. As you read the answers, this can give you some clues as to what the question is looking for.

Types of NCLEX Questions and How They Are Written

Once you have identified the key word, it will help you focus on what exactly the question wants you to answer. - Repeated words. The same words may appear in the NCLEX question and in the correct answer. It may be the same word or a synonym of the word. This strategy can help you identify correct answer choices. - Odd answers
